










# THE (MONNET)-SCHUMAN DECLARATION 9 MAY 1950



# EU SURFACE AREA COMPARED TO THE REST OF THE WORLD


Surface area (x 1000 km<sup>2</sup>)






# HOW RICH IS THE EU COMPARED TO THE REST OF THE WORLD?


