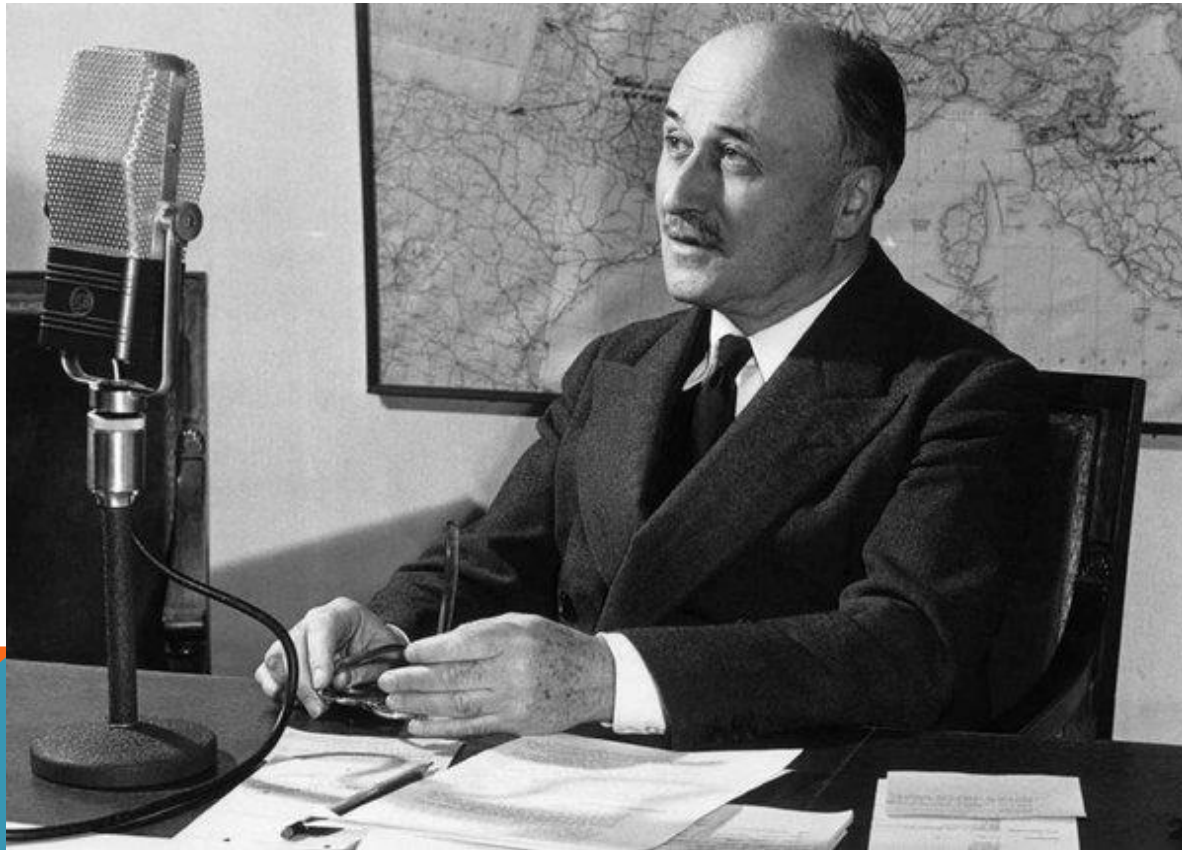

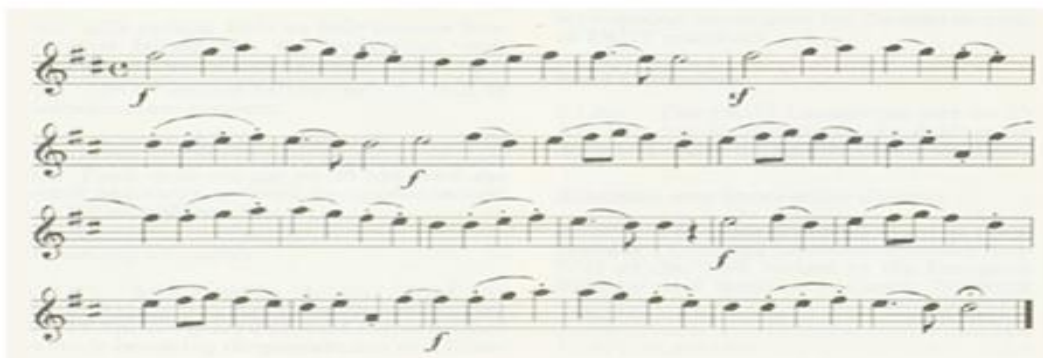

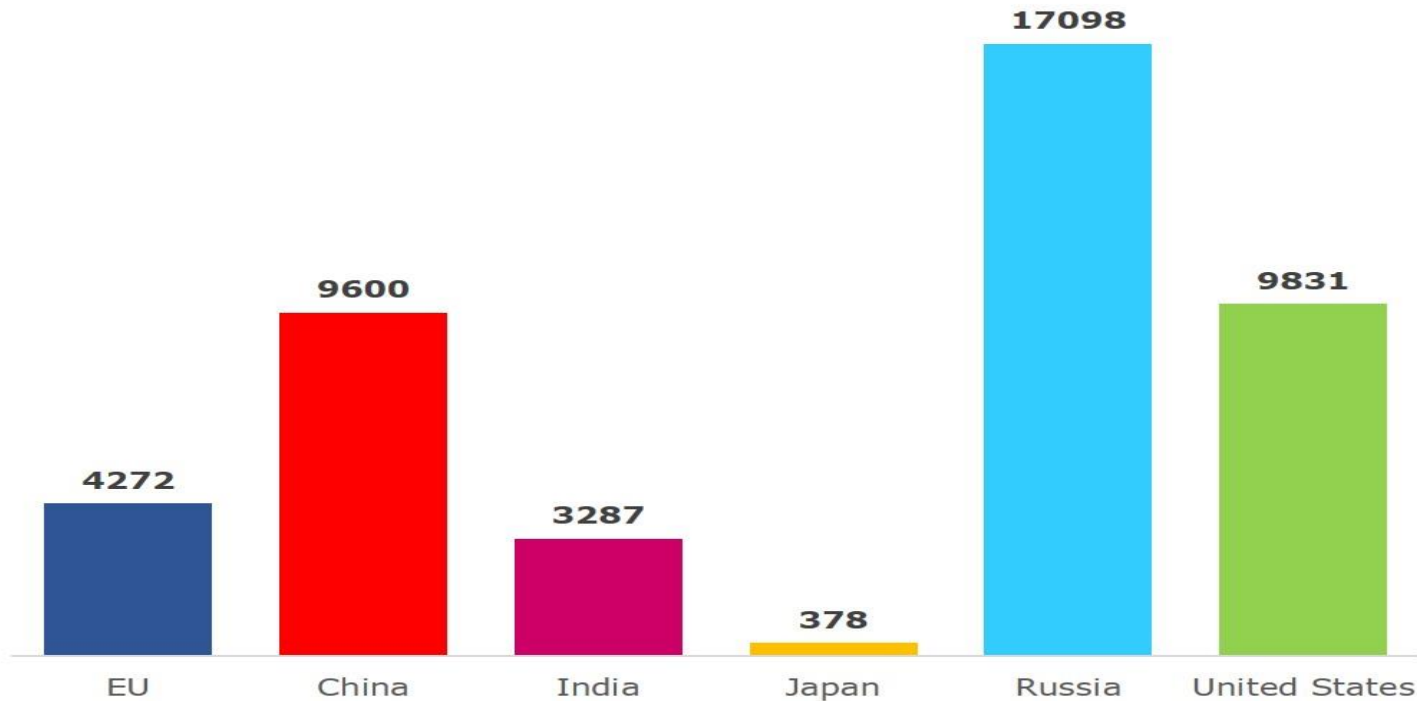

EU SURFACE AREA COMPARED TO THE REST OF THE WORLD

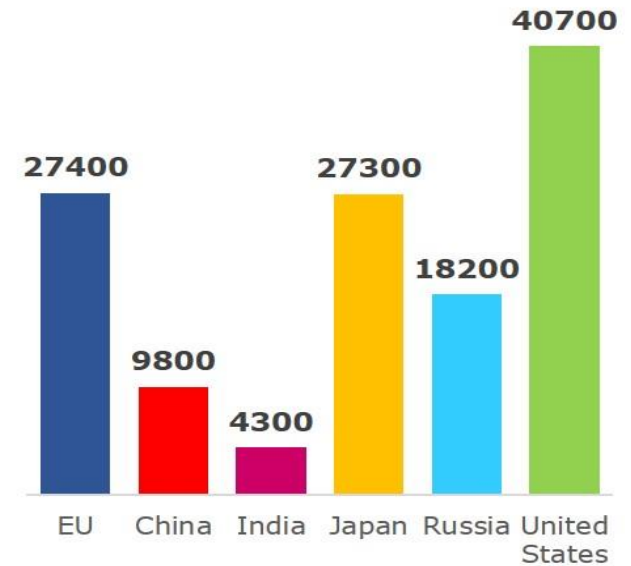
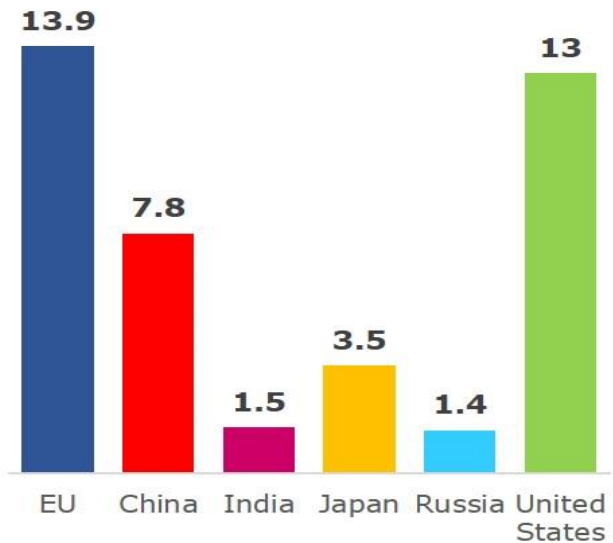
Surface area (x 1000 km²)

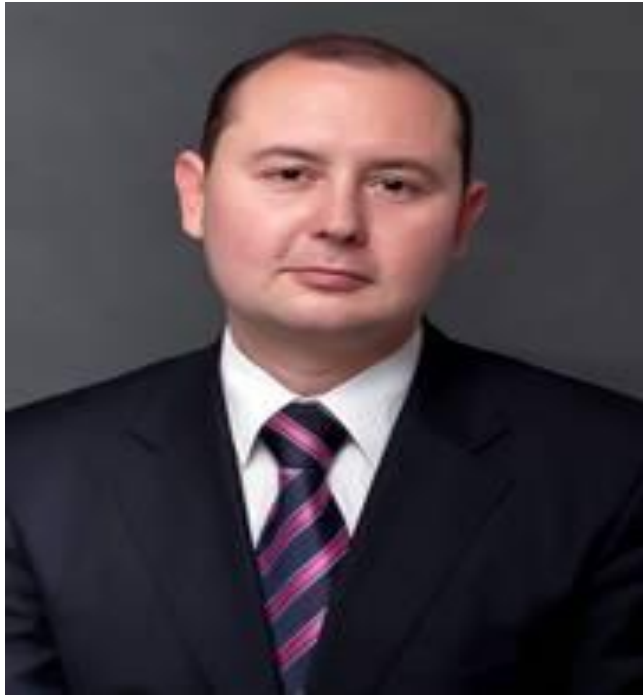
